- The termly plan is billed in three installments while the monthly plan is billed in ten installments.
- Founding families are families that have been continuously enrolled since the 2023-24 school year.

Transportation

Transportation services are available for families in Cascais (€100 per child per month) and Ericeira (€200 per child per month), subject to minimum enrollment and a full-year commitment.

What's Included

Payment Terms

- The enrollment fee is payable upon admission for new students or by March 20 for returning students.
- The termly plan is billed in three installments due July 15, December 1, and March 1.
- The monthly plan is billed in ten equal installments, beginning on July 15 and continuing on the 15th of each month through April 15.
- The selected payment plan applies for the full academic year and cannot be changed after enrollment.
- Mid-year entries may only select the termly payment plan.
- Withdrawals are subject to the following notice deadlines: July 1 for Term 1, November 15 for Term 2, and February 15 for Term 3. If notice is received after the applicable deadline, the full tuition for that term remains payable.
- Late fees apply as follows: 2% (1–7 days overdue), 5% (8–14 days overdue), and 10% (15+ days overdue), calculated on the outstanding balance.
